Bring **ONLY** accepted materials on the appropriate day.

For example, residents bringing paint to an electronics collection event will be directed to return on the correct drop-off day.

If you need to dispose of items from more than one category, please bring them to the All in One Drop-off Days.



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

9 am - 1 pm

Fourth Thursday of the month May - July:
May 25, June 22, July 27

What to bring:

motor oil	fluorescent bulbs
gasoline	lawn/garden chemicals
antifreeze	glues & adhesives
mercury	lead acid batteries
wiper fluid	misc cleaners
kerosene	degreasers
acids	metal cleaners
aerosols	smoke detectors

Also accepting unwanted over-the-counter and prescription medications & eyeglasses/eyeglass cases

NOTE: Bring paint to special PAINT WEDNESDAY drop off days.



ALL IN ONE DROP-OFF DAYS

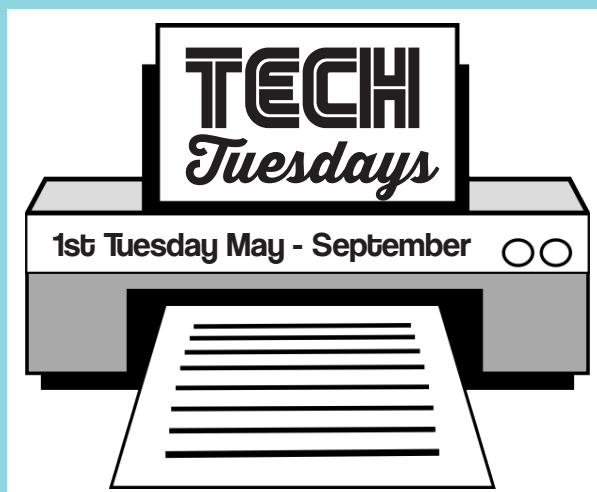
For individuals who cannot make weekday daytime events, we have added these all-in-one drop-off days!

What to bring:

Household Hazardous Waste (see HHW list)
Electronics (see Tech Tuesday list)
Paint (see Paint Wednesday list)



9 am - 1 pm

First Tuesday of each month:

May 2, June 6,

July 11 (due to Independence Day holiday),

August 1, September 5

What to bring:

televisions	monitors
computers	laptops
phones	keyboards
scanners	cables & cords
hard drives	mice
tablets	fax machines
printers	misc parts

No fees to recycle your electronic items, including ALL televisions and computer monitors!

SAFE TRANSPORTATION TIPS

Do not mix different chemicals!

Leave substances in their original containers, and make sure caps and/or lids are securely closed. Place containers in sturdy boxes in an upright position.

Never transport leaking or open containers.

IMPORTANT:

We cannot accept unknown or unlabeled wastes at public drop-off events. If you have unknown chemicals, please call (989) 781-9555 to schedule a special appointment.

HOUSEHOLD Special Waste Program Rules:

Proof of Residency required
No farms, schools or businesses
No containers over 5 gallons
Containers will not be returned

Do NOT bring:

Business/farm wastes
Rechargeable batteries
Household batteries
Explosives or Ammunition
Propane tanks
Tires
